**MORAY COUNCIL (FOGWATT) REVOCATION OF TREE
PRESERVATION ORDER 2023**

MORAY COUNCIL, as Planning Authority, acting under Section 160 of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997 and other powers enabling it to do so hereby gives notice that on 19th April 2023 it made a Tree Preservation Order known as Moray Council (Fogwatt) Revocation of Tree Preservation Order 2023.

The effect of the Order will be to revoke The Moray Council (Fogwatt) Tree Preservation Order 2001. The grounds for making the Revocation Order are that the amenity value and wooded character of the area has been significantly impacted by development of the site and no longer provides the important amenity feature that the Tree Preservation Order was served for. The Order shall continue in force unless Moray Council fails to confirm the Order by 19th October 2023.
